Come out of your winter doldrums and share some fun with your AGO colleagues! Our January social this year will be a potluck at 6:30 pm on Friday, January 17th at Tates Creek Christian Church, 3150 Tates Creek Road in Lexington, and hosted by TCC's Worship Minister, Don Seever. Bring something good to eat to the church's Fellowship Hall (the closest entrance is the lower doors that face Immanuel Baptist; there's a covered entryway there that goes directly into Fellowship Hall). You will be able to purchase organ music and order choral music throughout the morning so bring your credit card or checkbook and take home some new pieces for Lent and Easter!
